

# 1" = 70 FT SCALE 10,000 TON SEA QUEST MODEL

## Easy no-glue assembly instructions

Carefully cut each Part from the sheet as indicated in order of assembly.

**STAGE 1.** Take Parts 1 and 2. Make each marked 1/2 inch deep, across the top. Disassemble Parts 3 and 4. Push 2 into 4 right in. Fold Part 5 across. Part 7 and 8. Insert the ends of Part 1 and 6 into Part 7 and glue Part 6 to Part 7. Locate the other end of Part 5 into Part 3 and glue Part 4 onto Part 3. Fit Part 10 into holes in Part 5 and fit Part 11 to Part 5.

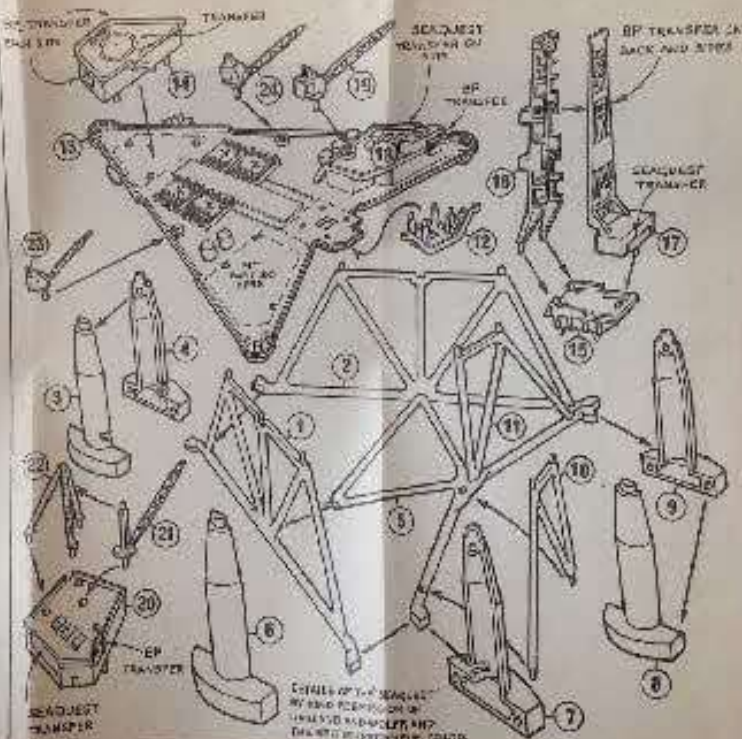
**STAGE 2.** Fit Part 12 into the four holes underneath Part 10. Locate all the rest of Parts 1, 2, 10, 11 and the three legs on the bottom into their holes under Part 12.

**STAGE 3.** Fit Part 14 to Part 10. Fit Part 16 into the four holes in Part 13. Fit Parts 16 and 17 together and glue into the three holes in Part 15. Fit Part 18 into Part 13 and Part 14 into Part 18. Fit Part 20 into Part 13. Fit Part 21 to Part 22 and glue them into the four holes in Part 20. Fit Part 19 into Part 23 and 24 into the holes in Part 22.

**STAGE 4.** Paint in three 1/2 inch thick grey. Darker grey on Parts 12, 13, 14, 16, 18, 19. Light Grey. Side of Part 14, 16, 17. Part 10 and 11, side of Part 12 and stick on Part 10. White. Also the two round tanks in Part 13. The four strips of glass make a white shade. Part 16, 21, 22, 23 and 24. Orange.

**STAGE 5.** The Transfer box concept looks to accept cut when cutting out so allow your fingers to grip them. Fit them into place with a small amount of pressure is OK.

The Sea Quest is now complete and is ready to sail on the water. In those conditions it is a beauty on the sea. Buy Sea Quest in volume quantity 30000 to 1000000 each.
