







Paul references their past and their concerns

- **These are Jews in the Diaspora (scattering)**
- **He reminds them of their history v16-20**
- **He reminds them of King David v22**
- **He reminds them of the promise of a Messiah v22**

Paul tells them that Jesus is the answer

“Therefore, my friends, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you.

Through him everyone who believes is set free from every sin, a justification you were not able to obtain under the law of Moses”.

Acts 13 v38-39

Paul challenges them for a response

- **He warns them that the people of Jerusalem and their leaders failed to recognise Jesus as the Messiah**
- **He warns them not to make the same mistake**

Paul and Barnabas faced opposition

- **This should be expected when the good news is preached**
- **The disciples welcomed it**
 - “The disciples were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit” Acts 13 v 52**
