God is a forgiving Father!



Intro	<p>We are learning about another story that Jesus told in the Bible today. It's often called the story about the "Prodigal son."</p> <p>To help us get started, can you think of a time when you did something and then had to sorry for doing it? Did the person forgive you? How did you feel?</p>
Re-cap	<p>Can you remember the story from last week? It was Jesus telling us a story about what God's kingdom is like. It's like finding the most valuable treasure! What can you learn about God from this story in Luke chapter 15 verses 11 to 32.</p>

Questions	<p>Complete the Prodigal Son picture quiz!</p> <p>If you have time, why not give the crossword a go (answers are on the back!)</p>
Memory verse	<p>"Jesus said, "In the same way God's angels are happy when even one person turns to him." Luke 15 verse 10</p>
Craft	<p>The father runs to his lost son and hugs him! He is a forgiving father. Can you create a hug? Draw around your hands with a pencil and then cut them out (or use the hand templates). Stick them on either side of the blue strip. Decorate your person template (self portrait or a picture of the forgiving Father) and add your memory verse in the middle. 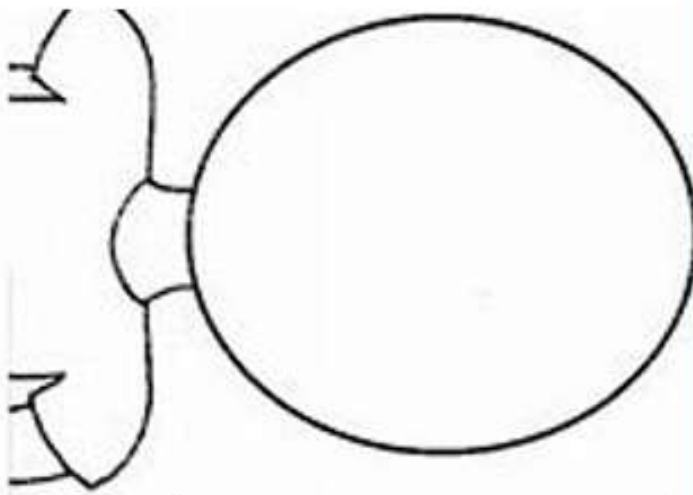
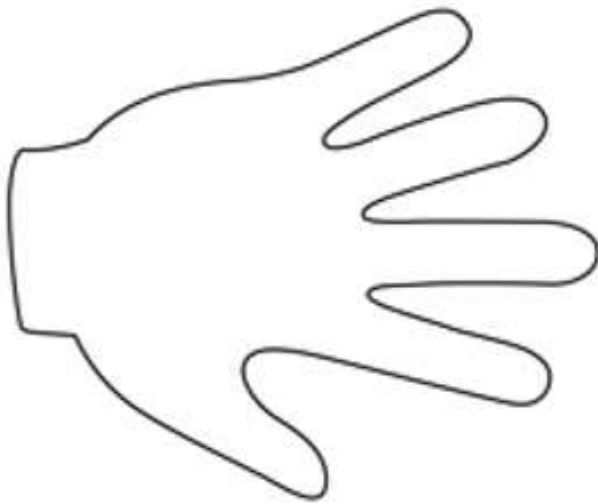


When he was so hungry, who did he decide to go and see?



How did the father feel about this?

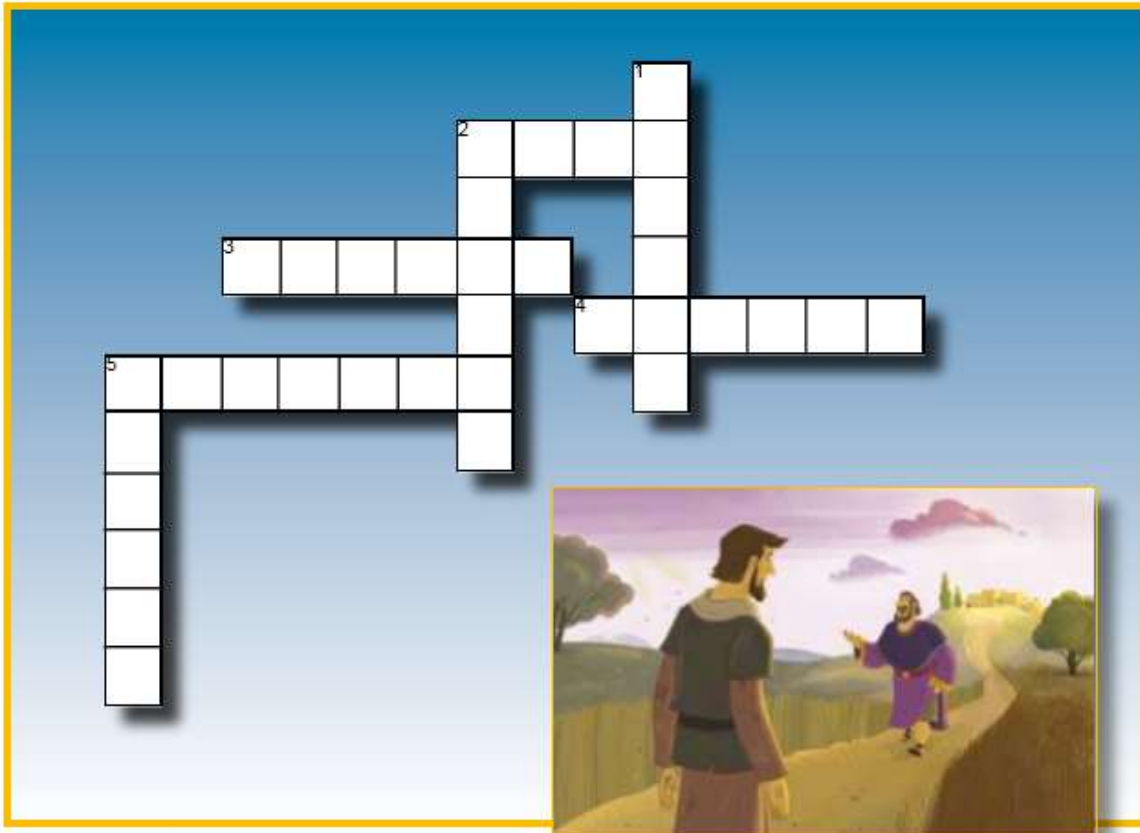
