




Elijah

| Intro | After Solomon, there lived a man called Elijah. Did you know that back in those days, people didn't have the complete Bible (the word of God) that we do today? So God would speak through special people called prophets. Elijah was a prophet! |
| Context | Elijah lived during the time of evil king Ahab and queen Jezebel. They were not friends with God and were trying to turn people away from him. Elijah felt like he was the only follower of God - how would you feel if that were you? |
| Activity | Can you help Elijah to beat the evil king Ahab to the place called Jezreel? (maze) |

| Questions | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What was the name of the king and queen? <i>Ahab and Jezebel</i> 2. Who did they worship instead of God? <i>Baal</i> 3. How do we know that Baal was not a real God? 4. How did God show himself to be God? <i>(accept answers, God showed himself to be all powerful - he could cause the altar to catch fire even when it was really wet! He caused it to rain - he controls the rain and the clouds. He caused Elijah to run at super human speed!)</i> 5. After how many years did it finally rain? <i>3 years</i> 6. What do you think this teaches us about God? <i>He is the one, true God</i> |


So Elijah wrapped his coat around himself, and the LORD gave him strength to run all the way to Jezreel.
