Elijah and Elisha

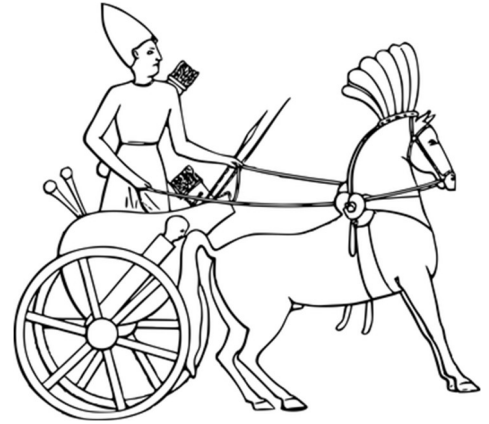
