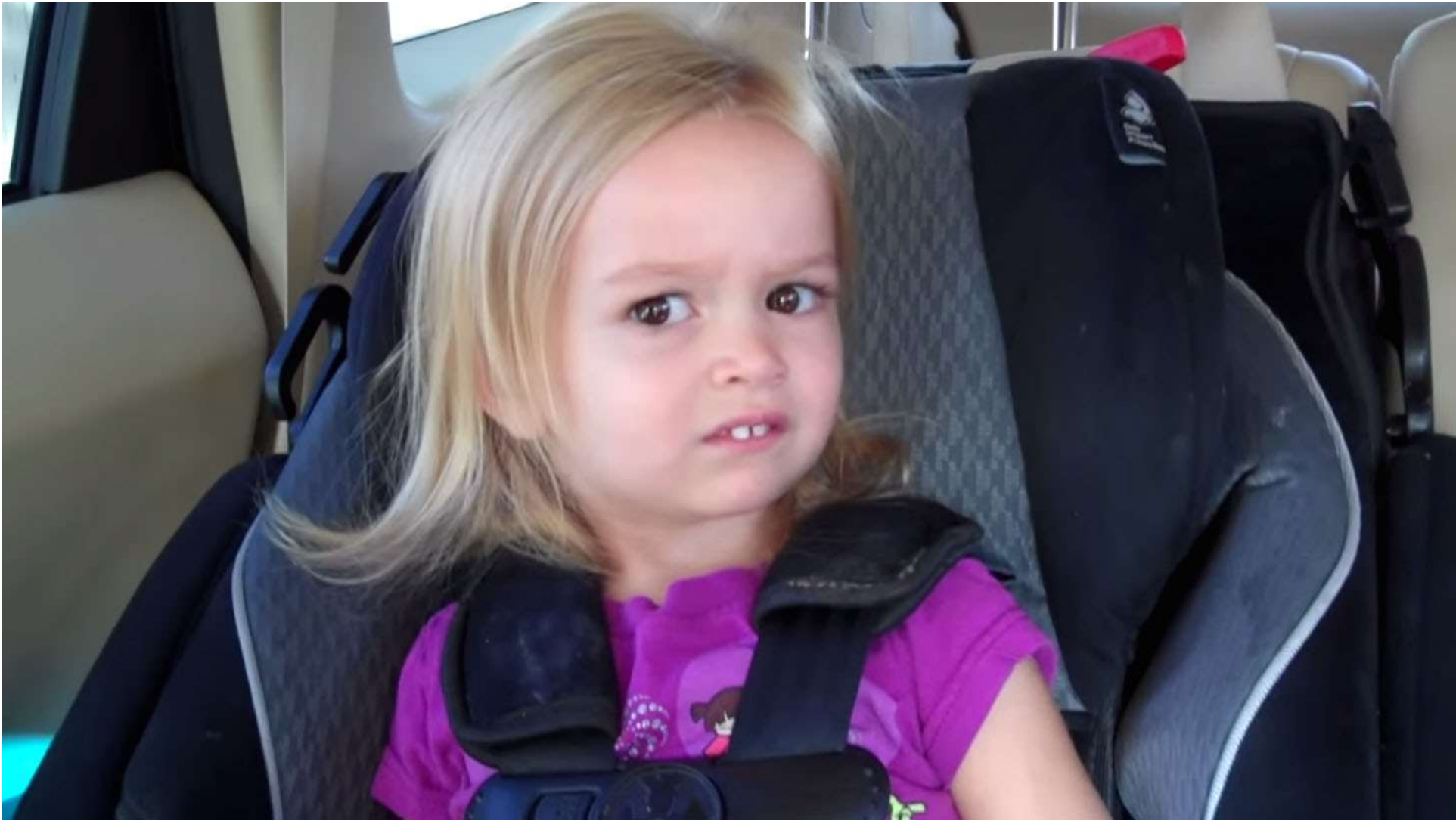


Genesis 4
